Chongqing: the biggest city in the world

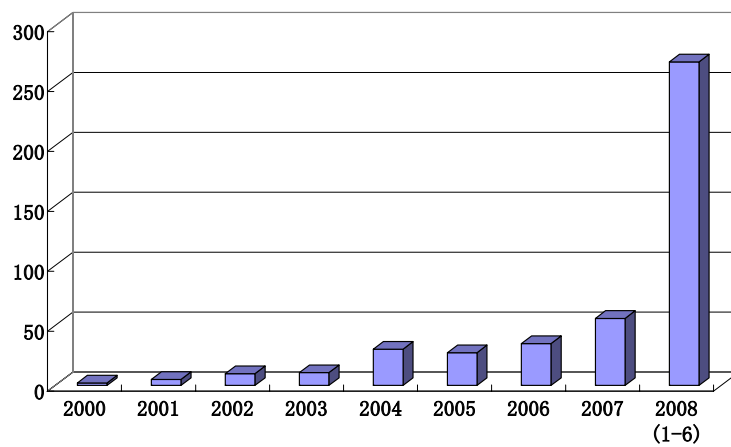

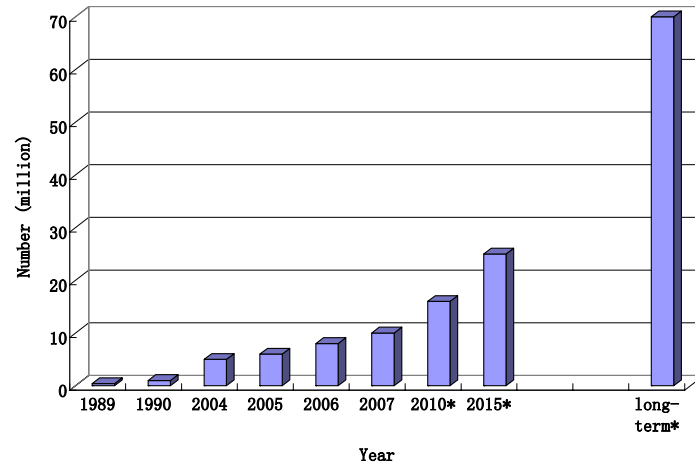


Rapid growth of foreign investment

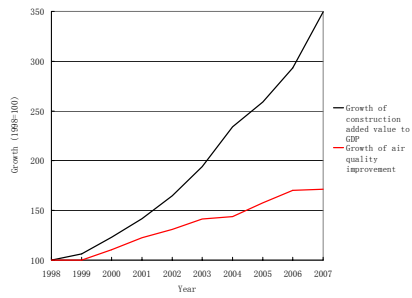
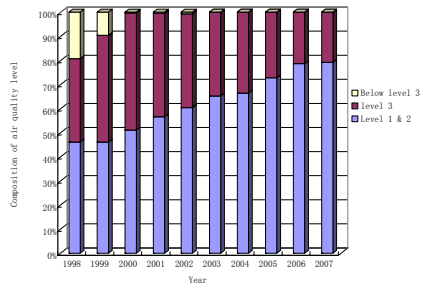
Fact and (target): growth of airline passengers
