## Market Leader dmlpe32 DLL Upgrade

---

This document will provide a solution to the error, "C:\Dml95NT\dml.exe performed an illegal operation..." when importing a zip file into Market Leader.

1. Please close all programs (particularly Market Leader) before proceeding.
2. Find the file dmlpe32.dll on your computer
  - 2.1. Open Windows Explorer to search for and locate the dmlpe32.dll
    - 2.1.1. This file will most likely be in the C:\Windows\System32 or C:\Windows\System
    - 2.1.1.1. For Windows NT users: C:\Winnt\system32 or C:\Winnt\system
  - 2.2. Note the location of the existing dmlpe32.dll file (c:\windows\system32\dmlpe32.dll)
3. Download the new dmlpe32.dll file from the Dodge Support website
  - 3.1. Download the 512E10a-dmlpe32.exe file to C:\
    - 3.1.1. Using Windows Explorer, go to C:\ and locate 512E10a-dmlpe32.exe
    - 3.1.2. This is a self-extracting zip file. Double-click on the filename to decompress it
    - 3.1.3. File dmlpe32.dll will be placed on your local drive under c:\dodge\_512E10a\
    - 3.1.4. Go to C:\dodge\_512E10a\ and copy the new dmlpe32.dll to the location noted before (where the existing file was found earlier)
    - 3.1.5. You will be prompted to overwrite the existing file - select "Yes" to do so.
4. Run the Market Leader Maintenance Program (Repair & Compact)

Now you should be able to open Market Leader and perform your imports without error.
